Keynote Speakers



Dr Nick Mabbot – Fatigue Risk Management Specialist, Beyond Midnight Consulting

Sleep, Injury Prevention and Improved Health & Wellness.

Dr Nick illustrates how sleep cleans the brain of toxins and damaging proteins, resulting in reduced risk of ageing brain diseases such as Alzheimer's, Lewy Body Syndrome and Parkinson's Disease. He further states the homeostatic requirement for sleep in which we recycle brain energy for the following day. This helps to explain what a 'sleep debt' is and how the homeostatic drive for sleep creates the impairment observed in humans, which can lead to errors in the workplace.

Dr Nick also discusses how each stage of sleep provides something wonderful for humans. Walking through the stages of sleep, and how sleep architecture changes with sleep restriction, people are often reflect on how they have felt on different days. With an emphasis on Type II Diabetes, and other human ailments, Dr Nick extracts information from his "Science of Sleep" program, along with healthy eating and physical movement, to illustrate how you can be in more control of your health and wellness.




Soa Palelei – Wellness Ambassador & mental Health Advocate, Strong Minds, Strong Mines
